DOUG DANGER



In 1994, Bruce Rossmeyer took his love for motorcycles to the road when he began the first Ride for Children event to raise money for children with serious illnesses to attend Camp Boggy Creek. As a Founder and Board Member of Camp Boggy Creek, Bruce Rossmeyer immediately recognized the need to enrich the lives of children with serious illnesses and provide them with camp experiences that are memorable, exciting, fun, empowering, physically safe and medically-sound.

Children and their families are never charged fees to attend Camp Boggy Creek and Bruce Rossmeyer was dedicated to continuing Boggy Creek's mission of compassion, its legacy of caring, and its commitment to give a "week of normal" to children with serious illnesses. The

Ride for Children was very successful due to Bruce's personal involvement and commitment. He encouraged his personal and business associates to make contributions that went directly to help the children who attend Camp Boggy Creek. Since its inaugural run 29 years ago, it has raised over \$7 million for Boggy Creek campers.

A camp staff member reflected about an on-stage presentation during the early years of the Ride, where a nine-year-old camper joined Bruce on stage to present his thank you gift. As the little girl read the inscription on the thank you plaque, tears began to run down the "big man's" face. When it came to the children of Camp Boggy Creek, there was no softer heart.
